The territory is divided into two parts: the Zamin State Reserve and the Zamin people's Park, which is located on the northern ridges of the Turkestan mountains, bordering on each other. Zamin State Reserve has an area of 26840 on the territory of Zomin and Bahmal districts and was established in 1960 year. Zamin people's Park was founded in 1978 year, in the Zamin District of Jizzakh region it forms an area of 24110 ha. The reserve provides for the protection and inviolability of all natural resources in its territory. The people's Park was established for the purpose of conservation, restoration and recreational research of unique mountain ecosystems. Qarag'ay forests are one of the largest forests in the area. There are rare species of animals (14 pieces) and plants (18 pieces) included in the Red Book of Uzbekistan. The reason why the territory has been protected to a different extent since 1913 year, unique natural resources have been preserved.

✓ The Zomin state mountain Spruce Reserve, which is located in a large area, and the total area of The Velvet forest, Zomin Forest, which is part of it, is up to 26840 ha. zomin National Natural Park, which is equal to;

Nurota ridges surround its southern, partly Western and part of the Oasis, providing a temperate climate, as well as providing relief and natural beauty to the system of the Aydar-Arnasay lakes in the north of the region;

✓ National sanatorium-sanatorium" Zaamin"

Zomin National Park has a health resort "Zomin" at an altitude of 2 thousand meters above sea level. The freshest air, mountain landscapes, coniferous plants - all this is the best conditions for the passage of medical procedures to adults and children.

✓ Ancient pilgrims and ParpiAyim complex.

The aroma of different flowers and herbs will not leave you during the journey, but the moods will change so often that you will not grow to enjoy all these wonderful smells. But apart from all the natural beauties that are unique, this territory is also famous for its ancient history. Here you can meet the ruins of castles and monuments of different eras. But the reserve, established in 1960 year to preserve the unique nature of this land, is considered the most basic attraction. The area of this park reaches 10,5 hectares, and a large part of it consists of forests



Also in the reserve you can find mountain ranges, villages and address. The highest part of the mountain range is the Shavkatmountain, whose height is more than 4000 meters. Among the attractions of this reserve is the "Grandfather Frost" – according to calculations, the walnut tree, which is about 700 years old, is distinguished separately. Its height reaches 20 meters, and its diameter almost 3 meters. Not far from the reserve, a very interesting cave was found in the village. Archaeologists found from inside it the labor weapons of primitive people, while the cave walls were decorated with paintings. On the territory of the reserve there is a sanatorium "Zaamin" and a number of other boarding houses and children's camps.
